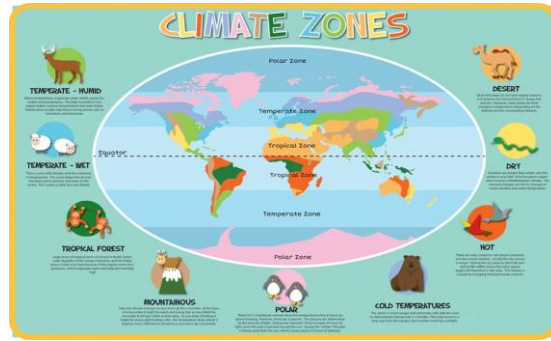




Autumn term 2026 in Monkey Puzzle class, Year 3 and 4.

I do hope you had a nice summer. This autumn term the topic in our class is all about climates and biomes (wildlife) in different parts of the world. The children will be learning lots of geographical aspects within this topic, plus we will incorporate other subjects including art and design.
