Book Fair

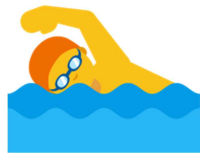
Thank you for the wonderful support shown to the Book Fair again this year. School received £300.00 worth of books in return for hosting the event.
