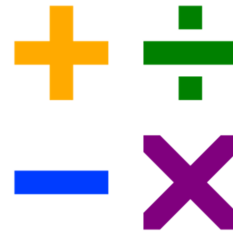

11th November. It is a quick, simple nasal spray.



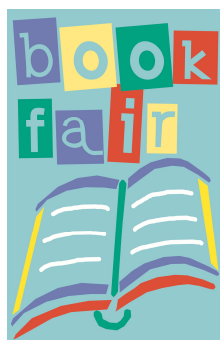
Phonics Workshop

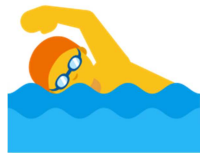


Gymnastics Club
